when the snow is new.

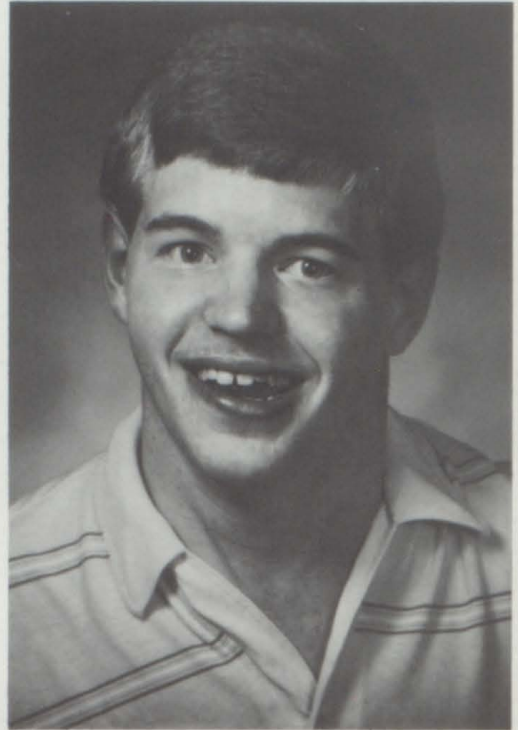
I've saved some sunlight

44 students presented the musical.

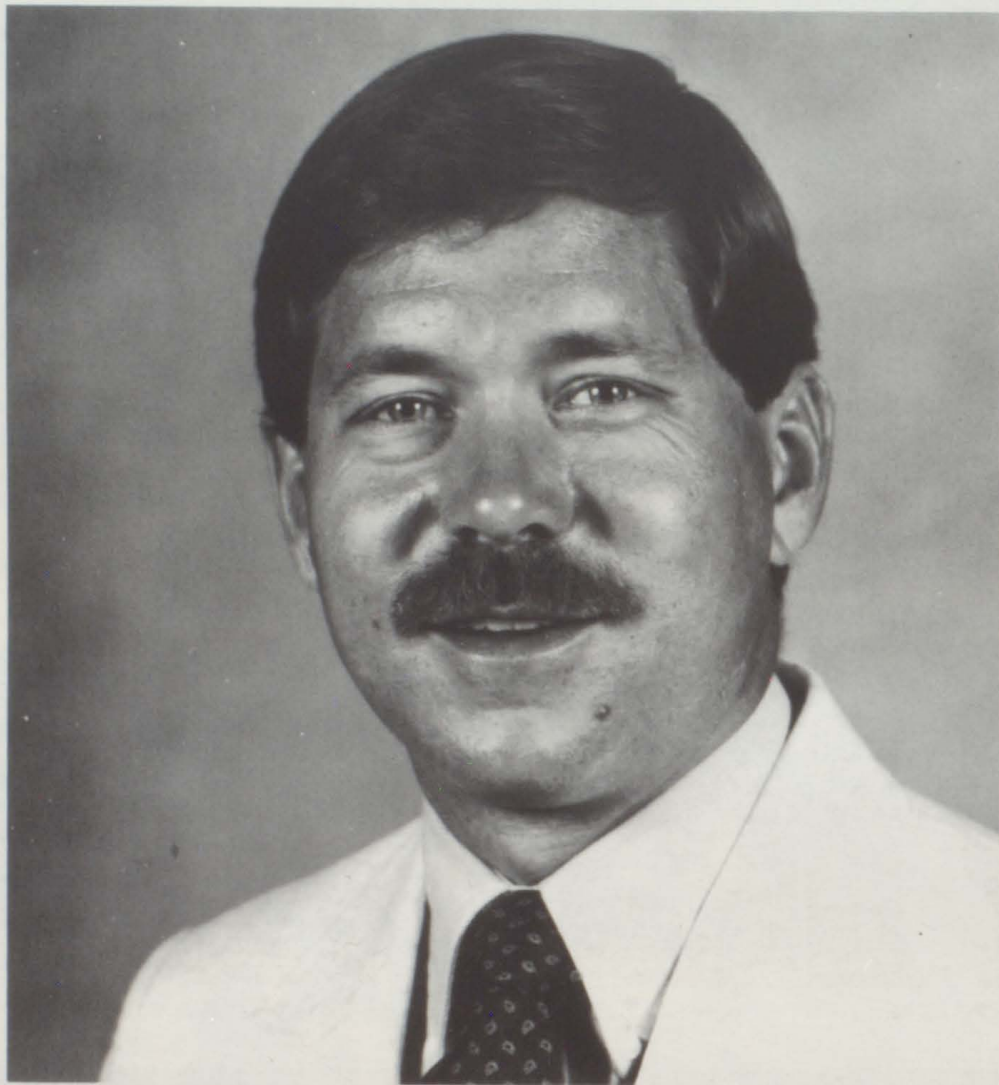

Knowing it means a great deal.

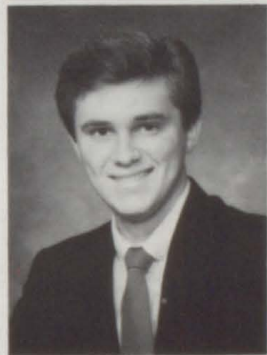
