The 1972 football season was one of ups and downs. The Burg opened the season with a close loss to Benjamin-Logan, 21-13, but followed the next week with a resounding win over West LibertySalem. As the Indians opened their league schedule with Jonathan-Alder, they were hampered with injuries to key personnel. While trying to recover, the team was saddled with defeats by Southeastern, Cedarville, and Madison Plains.
Burg gridmen got back on the winning track with win in a non-league contest over Yellow Springs. They finished the season on a strong note with league victories over Greenview and a convincing 34-0 win over cross-country rival, Triad. Post season honors were awarded to Ken Durand, named All-DVL Tackle, Most Valuable Player, and Outstanding Offensive and Defensive Lineman. Jim Gannon was named Honorable Mention DVI Guard and Coach's Honorary Captain. Kevin Rutan received All-DVI End Honors and Tom Jones was also named All-DVL at Halfback position and Outstanding Offensive Back. Dave Cron won DVL Honorable Mention at Linebacker position and Bill Keller was the Outstanding Defensive Back and Bruce Chester, the Most Inspirational Player. Chris Arthur was also named Most Improved Player.
