Interview With Mrs. Gabbard

Mrs. Gabbard retired this January after teaching for 20 years at Mechanicsburg High School. Before coming to MHS, Mrs. Gabbard grew up 3 hours away from here, just North of Wooster in Smithville, Ohio. After graduating, she attended Wittenberg University to become a teacher. She then pursued her teaching career at both Springfield City Schools and Northwestern in the subject of reading. Here at the 'Burg she taught Jr. High Reading, Journalism, American Literature-English 10, and English 12. She says her profession as a teacher has changed over the years, because she has become more professional and unified in the goals of the students. Her most

important aspect of teaching is making students feel successful with language and appreciating the wide expanse of literature. A friendly demeanor and a willingness to learn is what she values the most in a student. When asked about her past students she said that, "There have been outstanding students in every class. I enjoy hearing from or having visits from past students who are successful adults." The high point of her career comes every year at graduation when hopeful young people enter a new phase of life. As Mrs. Gabbard leaves Mechanicsburg she says she will miss her colleagues and the students the most, but what she will miss the least is the long drive in the dark on wintry mornings. Mrs. Gabbard's retirement plan is to focus on her family first and help with the care of her mother. She hopes to have time to sit by the ocean and contemplate the meaning of life, finish remodelling her house, and participate in some hobbies. Mrs. Gabbard says maybe she'll even write about her life in the Burg.



Interview With Mr. Runyan

Mr. Runyan retired this past spring after teaching at Mechanicsburg High School for 26 years. He was born and raised in Urbana, Ohio and attended Ohio State to pursue his career in Agriculture. Before coming to MHS, Mr. Runyan taught Industrial Tech at Indian Lake and Farm Management at Springfield JVS. Here at the 'Burg, he has taught Ag Business I and II, Ag Science I and II, and Horticulture. Mr. Runyan chose a teaching career because he was able to maintain his outside interests in the agricultural community. During

his many years of teaching he says there have been ups and downs, and he has developed patience. The rewards have been when he was able to facilitate students to do their best. His most memorable experiences include all the FFA trips to the FFA National Convention in Kansas City and the Louisville trips both of which provided challenges to his students. Over the course of teaching so many years at the 'Burg Mr. Runyan says the program has grown and changed from having primarily farm students participate to including many city kids as well. Upon retiring Mr. Runyan plans to continue his involvement in various agricultural interests.

The Juniors Say Thanks

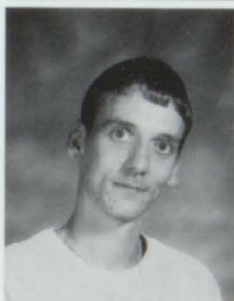

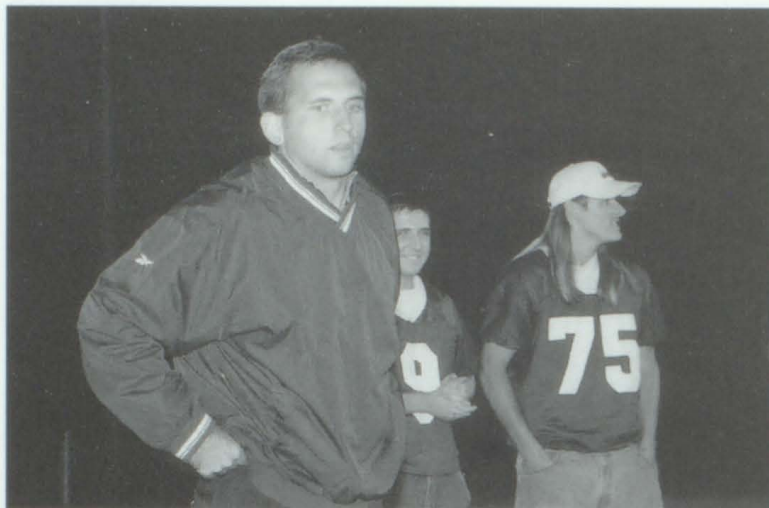

The 2000-2001 Varsity Wrestling team faced an uphill battle all season long. Without any seniors on the team, and only 7 wrestlers in the varsity lineup, the Indians struggled to post positive results in tournaments or dual meets. Posting a 5-12 dual meet record for the season, our best showing at tournament time was 14th out of 23 at Reading and 6th of 12 at the Sectional Tournament. The surprising WCOC runner up finish ended the season on a high note. Individually, Steve Showalter paced the Indian grapplers by posting a 3rd place showing at Sectionals and following that with a 4th place at Districts, to qualify for the State Tournament at 140 lbs.
